NOT INCLUDED IN BASIC INSTALLATION PRICE

- Assembly of ladders, steps, fencing or decking.
- Assembly of pool closer than 8" to an existing deck.
- Backfilling or landscaping around the outer edge of pool.
- Removal of trees, roots, stumps, or foreign debris discovered before or during excavation/construction.
- Removal of dirt from the pool site.
- Removal of packaging material/boxes.
- Electrical or gas hook up.

WHAT YOU MUST PROVIDE

ACCESS INTO YARD

We also need to have 10' clearance overhead from utility lines. Remember when considering your pool site to "look up" to check for power lines.

YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR:

Building permits:

Homeowner must provide a valid building permit to the installer prior to installation. Homeowner is also responsible for any decking, fencing, or electrical permits and their costs.

Underground utilities:

Any existing underground utilities must be marked <u>by the utility company</u>. Ohio customers should call 1-800-362-2764. Michigan customers should call 1-800-482-7171. Please call at least one week prior to your installation date.

All electrical hook ups:

Ground fault circuit interrupted (GFI) protection is **required** by National Electric Code in all communities.

Access to a clear and unobstructed pool site:

The pool site should be clearly marked in regards to: pool location, filter location, and excavated dirt.

Water supply:

The ability to begin filling the pool must be available on demand. Hoses should reach to the center of the pool.

Pool and accessory merchandise:

Must be paid in full prior to delivery and installation.

PAYMENT FOR INSTALLATION/EXCAVATION SERVICES

All installation/excavation services are to be paid directly to the installer on the day of installation. Payment at the job site may be made to Stone Pools in the form of personal check, money order, cash, or we gladly accept Visa or Master Card payments simply by calling the office at 419-697-7504 or 1-866-524-4724.

LIMITED INSTALLATION WARRANTY

Stone Pools will at its sole discretion repair, replace, or re-install any component found to be unsatisfactory as a direct result of installer workmanship for a period of 90 days (or one swim season) which ever applies, after installation. Specifically and expressly excluded from this warranty, but not limited to the following: Pool out of level by one inch or less, wrinkles in the liner, small irregularities in sand floor and cove, problems caused by previous ground conditions (filled areas, poor drainage, nut grass, worms, moles, black mold or bugs etc.

The manufacturer does not replace lost water or chemicals. Please keep this information in mind when considering the purchase of water.

Stone Pools **WILL NOT** be held responsible for any missing or damaged parts in the manufacturers packaging process. Customer is responsible for return trip charges for missing or damaged parts. Please be sure to have a responsible party present at the time your pool is picked up or delivered to go through the check list provided. It is in your best interest to make sure all parts are present and accounted for.

ADDITIONAL LEVELING PRICE TABLE

Additional leveling is determined by using survey equipment to find the lowest point of your pool site and digging to make the rest of the site level with that low point.

If the site can be made level with the lowest point without having to dig over 6" deep, then leveling is included in the basic installation price.

If the installers must dig deeper than 6" to make the site level with the low point then additional leveling prices are listed on the chart below.

Stone Pools strives to make the installation of your new pool a smooth and enjoyable process. Following is a list of things to remember.

- 1) Purchase your pool.
- 2) Read and sign the installation agreement and disclaimer and mail or fax back to the office.
- 3) Obtain permit from local city or township zoning board or provide documentation that permits are not required in your area. The office does not need a copy of your permit, just have it on hand when the installers arrive.
- 4) Arrange for pick up or delivery of your pool with the store.
- 5) Call for an installation date. ALL INSTALLATION DATES ARE WEATHER PERMITTING!

YOU WILL BE ASKED:

To mark your yard with spray paint before the installers arrive. Please make these specific marks in your yard.

ROUND POOLS

- X for the center of the pool, no stakes or circles are required.
- D for dirt. This is where the installers will place the dirt and sod that is excavated from the site. This mark must be made within 10-15 feet of the pool site. Please remember we do not haul away excess dirt.
- F for filter. This mark is where you want the pump and filter placed.

OVAL POOLS

- X at the four "corners" of the pool.
- D for dirt within 10-15 feet of pool site.
- F for filter. Filter must be placed at one of the **ENDS** of an oval pool. They cannot be put on the straight wall.

ADDITIONAL SERVICE OPTION

Stone Pools strives for a lifetime of service with you. Your pool is an expensive investment that requires routine care and maintenance. It is important that when you close your pool for the season the pool is "wintered over" properly. Failure to do so can result in ice damage that can tear liners and dent pool walls or cause damage to skimmers. Stone pools offers pool closing services that will warranty the closing is done properly. This closing is usually done at a reduced price for the first season you own your pool. The closing includes cleaning and storing of equipment, winterizing chemicals and covering of pool. We are happy to provide closings and openings of pools for our customers and carry with us any equipment or chemicals you may need. To make arrangements for these services simply ask your installer about them when they are installing your pool or call the office and we will be happy to assist you.

WINTER COVERS

Stone Pools has professionally winterized pools for the past 20 years. We feel it is important for our customers to know that if you live in a high wind area (out in the country) for example it is not uncommon for winter covers to be blown off. Larger pools are particularly susceptible to this. Regrettably, Stone Pools cannot be held liable for high wind conditions in rural or urban areas, or for the blowing or ripping of winter covers. Should you choose to have our installers professionally winterize your pool, they can and will to the best of their ability assess your pool location and advise you on the best way to anchor your cover.
